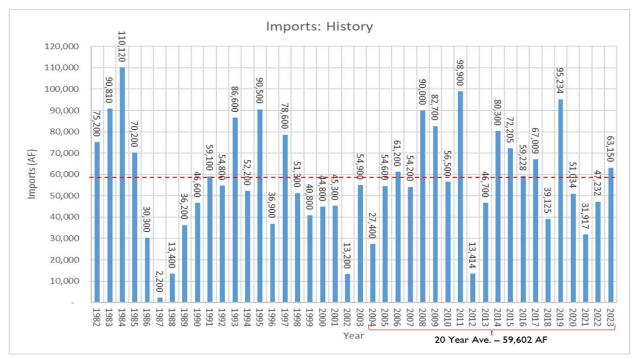
2024 PROPOSED BUDGET

Garrett Markus provided a PowerPoint presentation describing the Fryingpan-Arkansas Project Water (Project Water) and storage revenue projected for the 2024 budget.

Project Water First Use is 60 percent of the cost and of the use. For budgeting purpose, a 20-year rolling average is adopted, current average is 59,602 AF at 86.1 percent compared to the actual design yield of 69,200 AF at 100 percent difference of 9,598 AF.
